Class Work

Refers to any work completed in class. Examples are bell work, group work, short writing assignments, etc.

I enter grades in Powerschool on Fridays. It is the scholar and his or her family's responsibility to check grades regularly. Log in information is available from the front office.

I do NOT accept late work.
I do NOT do test re-takes.
I do NOT give individual extra credit.

I expect that you will do your best work the first time and that it will be turned in on schedule.

Come to class prepared to learn every day!

Missed tests will be made up after school on the day the scholar returns.

Any work assigned prior to the absence is due the day the scholar returns.

It is the scholar's responsibility to come to me and collect assignments that were missed due to absence.

Bathroom visits should be made during passing period.

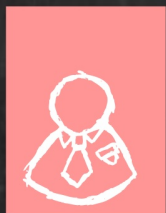
All cell phones are required to be in "cell phone parking" during class.
